Due to library closures across the nation in response to COVID-19, the HathiTrust Digital Library has implemented an Emergency Temporary Access Service which permits SJSU Library users special access to over 17+ million digitized items. This service will continue through the Fall 2020 semester and provides access to 56% of the library's print collections.
