ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Library Research Fellows are graduate and undergraduate students that are highly skilled and trained to provide library research assistance to a select audience of students. Library Research Fellows work directly with librarians to assist with helping individuals and groups find and use library collections and services successfully. Library Research Fellows may also provide support for librarians leading library programs and services such as data management, assessment, scholarly communications, etc. The fellows report to, and assists with, the delivery of liaison and functional responsibilities of their assigned librarian. These duties may include:

- 1) Maintenance and updating of library instructional materials (print and digital)
- 2) Consultation with individuals regarding library resources and services
- 3) Collection and organization of assessment data and user feedback
- 4) Marketing and communications of library resources and services
- 5) Curation of exhibits
- 6) Event planning and coordination
- 7) Developing new digital learning objects
